Driving Directions

From North or South on I-5.

Take Interstate 5 towards Tacoma. Take Exit 132. Take Highway 16 to the Union Ave. exit. Go north on Union Avenue. At the first stop light, turn left on S 23rd and go up the hill to Bellarmine. Follow signs to general parking or to the handicapped accessible parking.

From Kitsap Peninsula

Take WA-Highway 16 East to Tacoma across the Tacoma Narrows Bridge. Take the Union Ave. exit. Turn left onto S Union Ave. At the first stop light, turn left onto S 23rd and go up the hill to Bellarmine. Follow signs to general parking or to the handicapped accessible parking.
