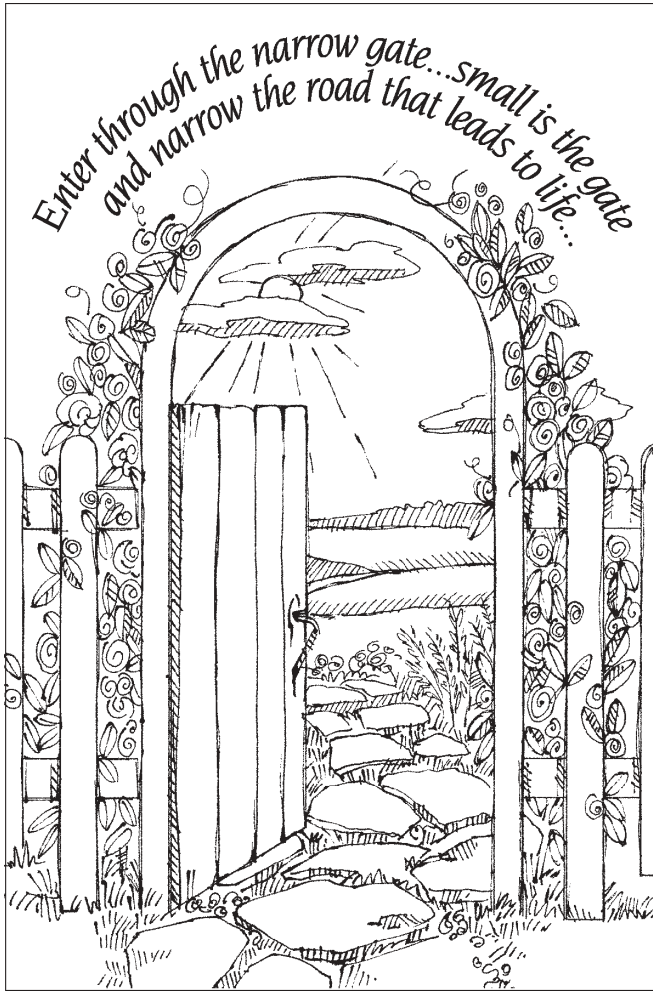

**A minimum non-refundable deposit of \$25 is required to reserve your place for this retreat.**

**Registration deadline: January 29, 2010.**

*The retreat is limited to the first 85 women who make a deposit. There are beds for 64 women at the retreat house and we will allow up to 21 commuters.*

**Retreat Fees:**

- Private Room: \$220 per person
- Shared Room: \$190 per person
- Commuter: \$88 per person

You may pay in full or make 5 easy payments of \$44/\$38/\$17.60 a month—the first \$25 of which is the non-refundable deposit to reserve your place.

**If you are unable to pay the full amount**, we have **limited partial** scholarships which will be awarded based on need. Scholarships will not be given for private rooms. **Send in your registration form with deposit and a letter explaining your need.** *Deadline to apply for a partial scholarship is January 22, 2010.* These will be considered in the order they are received.



Check in on Friday from 5:30-7:00 PM. The retreat closes on Sunday after lunch.  
**NO DINNER ON FRIDAY** Overnight guests enjoy 5 meals (Saturday breakfast, lunch, dinner; Sunday breakfast and lunch). Commuter guests enjoy 3 meals (Lunch & dinner on Saturday and lunch on Sunday).  
*A confirmation letter with driving directions will be mailed two weeks before the retreat.*
