A Holy Spirit Seminar is an opportunity for individuals to establish or re-establish and deepen their personal relationship with Jesus. It is also an opportunity to be very intentional about yielding to the action of the Holy Spirit in our lives. In the process, all who are involved, team members and participants alike, grow in their relationships with one another with a strong sense of Christian community. All are encouraged to deepen their personal prayer life and to appreciate more fully the Sacramental and Liturgical life of their parish. Any one of these elements alone would be enough to inspire a person to participate – how much more when *all* these elements are present at the same time!

There are a variety of models used for Holy Spirit Seminars. Some are done on a weekend or two, and some are offered over the course of many weeks. Some are done using DVD presentations along with small sharing groups, others are done with “live” teachings. But no matter what model is used, the good news is that people are blessed and God’s grace transforms hearts and lives.

I am very hopeful that we will have six or more Holy Spirit Seminars in the Fall, and hopefully we can double the amount next Spring.



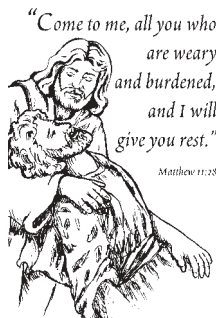
